

NOTICE OF TELEPHONIC PUBLIC INPUT HEARINGS

For Pike County Light and Power Company (Gas) and (Electric) Rate Increase Request

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission has scheduled two telephonic public input hearings to receive public comment on Pike County Light and Power Company (Gas) and (Electric)'s request to increase its natural gas distribution rates by \$262,000 per year or 16% and increase its electric distribution rates by \$1.93 million per year or 24.7%. These hearings are being held by telephone due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. Members of the public are welcome to attend the telephonic hearing and to provide comments for the public record. At this hearing, you will have the opportunity to present your views over the phone to the judge hearing the case and to the company representatives. The testimony given during the telephonic hearing has the same force and effect as if this hearing were held in person. All testimony given under oath becomes part of the official rate case record. The hearing is scheduled for two sessions as follows:
