



General Gas Technician

Role and Scope of Position:

This is an Operations position that will oversee the construction, operation and maintenance for the Pike County Light & Power natural gas distribution system located in Matamoras, PA. This individual will report to the Company's Milford office. This individual will be responsible for a variety of aspects of the system including construction, operations, maintenance, customer service, and community involvement. This individual will report to the Technical Chief – Gas.

Responsibilities:

- Turn-on and turn-off (installation and removal) new and existing gas and electric customer meters.
- Shut off notices and lock for non-payment activities for existing gas and electric customers.
- Construction inspection – At the direction of the Technical Chief – Gas will perform inspection and oversight of third-party contractors.
- Leak Investigation – Will be on-call (24 hours per day) to respond to gas leak/odor calls inside on customer facilities, outside on Company facilities and third-party damage calls. Will be required to properly investigate and classify the hazard and safely respond to and assure safety of customers, public, and self. Response required within Company specified timeframes.
- Locates and Mark-outs – Will respond to (normal and emergency) Underground Facility Locate requests (PA One Call; NY UDig) to locate and mark-out the Company facilities.
- Under the direction of the Technical Chief – Gas, perform some fitter type of work to include but not limited to (meter and regulator piping fabrication, service and main installation, PE pipe joining, leak and third-party damage repair, pressure testing, system purging, etc.)
- System Inspections - Will perform required periodic system inspections and surveys (leak survey, valve survey, station inspections, etc.).
- Under the direction of the Technical Chief – Gas, perform inspection, testing and maintenance of regulators, meters, meter correctors, heaters, filters, valves, odorizers, etc.
- Meter Reading – Will be responsible to read Company meters.
- Meter Changeouts – Will change gas meters and single-phase electric meters as necessary.
- Customer interaction – Be able to discuss the benefits of natural gas with potential gas customers, to assist current gas customers with issues related to their gas service, will hand out and accept applications for gas service, may accept bill payments.
- Will perform any special projects or assignments as deemed necessary.
- May perform other related assignments/special projects as required.
- Will create and maintain all records associated with above work.
- Will perform on-call emergency response.



Minimum Qualifications:

Technical Knowledge/Skill: This position requires a self-motivated individual capable of working and making decisions without direct supervision. Individual must have some mechanical knowledge. Requires strong organizational and managerial skills. Ability to use PC desktop/laptop applications (e.g., Microsoft Word and Excel). Will promote a customer service focus and reinforce customer excellence by being sensitive to the Company's public image. Will emphasize professionalism, honesty, concern, courtesy, excellence, and teamwork within the unit.

Education: Requires a minimum of a High School Diploma. Two-year technical degree preferred.

Experience: Plumbing, piping experience required. Three years of gas related experience preferred.

Licenses & Certifications: Must have valid driver's license. CDL driver preferred.

Company vehicle provided for company use. Must be willing to travel, if required, to other locations and Company territories.

Per Federal regulations, this position will require the individual to submit to and pass a pre-employment and random alcohol and drug testing.

The individual will be required to pass natural gas operator qualification and specific Company training/testing required for the position.
